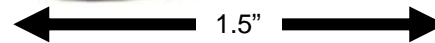

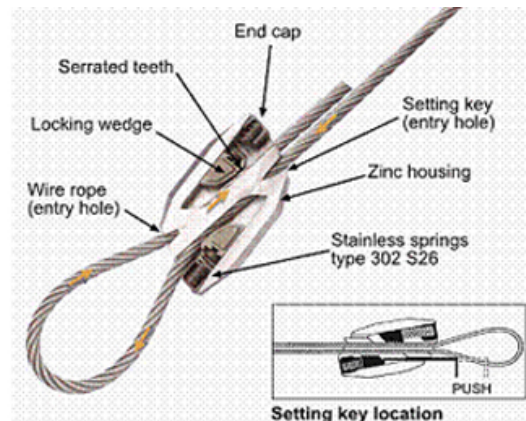
## GRIPPLE

Alternative to cable crimps or clamps



### Pro's:

- ideal cable stop for quick easy installations in cramped locations.
- 800lb holding strength. Secure tree revetments along stream banks.
- Medium size model fits 1/8" galvanized aircraft cable.
- no crimping tool required to fasten gripple to cable.
- reduced fatigue of work crews working in cold frigid waters.
- make adjustments after installation (recommend adjustments be made same day of installation. Silt from disturbed waters will clog mechanism in gripple after some time of immersion).
- removal of gripple possible with a rigid wire or supplied tool – setting key or large paper clip.
- added safety feature – no pinching of fingers from crimping tool.



### Con's

- bur's on cable ends must be removed prior to attempting Gripple installation.
- cost of Gripple is more expensive than crimps, however, cost in time savings especially in adverse conditions can easily justify the added expense.
- Work crews using gripple will be finished their installations long before those using crimps – guess they'll be buying the coffee.
